Dear Motor Medics,

I travel 50 miles each way to work each day and share the road with a lot of large long-haul trucks. It seems that they always think they own the road. They are either going too fast or too slow or cutting me off or any other number of things that seem just plain rude to me. Why can't they be more like other vehicles on the road? Not to say that all other vehicles are perfect drivers but it just seems as though the trucks are worse.

Dear Dan,

Trucks can't be like cars because there not cars. Most truck drivers are very courteous and with a little help from you they can be even better drivers. You have to remember that even the largest SUV, is a high-performance sports car when compared to a multi-ton truck. When you pull onto the interstate you can adjust your speed to stay clear of the trucks much faster than they can. Don't expect them to move quickly for you and never position yourself directly in front of a truck, if you stop quickly, they can't. If you feel you are being cut off often where are you driving? If you can't see their mirrors then the driver can't see you. Don't hog the passing lane going the speed limit either. They are slow uphill and fast down so share the road and leave the enforcement to the officers.

It's time to buy a new car, Fred has been a good van but it's time to give him a rest. Yes, I call my van Fred. We name all of our vehicles because they always have personality. We drive a 2003 Chevy Astro van and we made it 245,000 miles. Not bad for all original major components. We do listen to your show and follow your maintenance advice of course. We finally had the air conditioning fail and decided it is the end for Fred. We just want to know one thing. We always felt safe in Fred but never had a collision or factual evidence to back the safety up so how do we go about finding out how safe our new vehicle will be? Not sure if our new vehicle will be new or a couple years old yet.

Dear Motor Medics,

I have a general question about air bag safety. I heard you talking on a recent episode of Under The Hood about the testing of air bags and how they were tested differently in America and Overseas markets. The difference was in America they are tested with the use of a seat belt and Overseas sometimes without. I have never had an airbag deployed in my vehicle and I don't look forward to ever having it occur, but I want to know what to expect if it does and what I can do to prevent injury. Personally, I would rather not have airbags in my cars, but it doesn't look like they are going away. What is your take on people who ride with their feet on the dash or a pet in their laps?

Dear Janet,

Air bags are great inventions that have saved many lives but if misused can cause severe injury. Every car made has a guide for proper air bag use printed in the owner's manual and it needs to be followed. The proper distance between you and the airbag is crucial as well as seat belt use. Follow the guidelines in the manual and never place anything between you and the airbag. Anything placed in this zone will become a projectile, including a pet, and is extremely dangerous. As for feet on the dash, an inflating air bag can cause irreparable damage to them.

Dear Motor Medics,

My car has been overheating and the shop I have been going to can't seem to find the cause. It only seems to overheat when I drive it and I can't seem to find a pattern with it that I can use to have the shop duplicate the problem. On occasion I will find the heater stops blowing hot air and at the same time the temp gauge increases into the red zone. If I pull over and let the engine idle for a while it will cool down and the heat will come back. It has also done this at idle before. They want to replace head gaskets, but they aren't sure if they are bad. Is there anything I can do to find out for sure before we tear it apart and possibly don't find anything wrong with it?

Sorry to hear about Fred. Sound like he treated you well. When looking for another vehicle we suggest that you check out the web site www. safercars.gov where you can find and compare vehicle safety ratings. The NHTSA National Highway Traffic Safety Administration has certain testing specifications posted there that will aide you in making a decision based on safety factors. Reliability is also important when purchasing any vehicle so don't forget to look to providers such as consumer reports to help you get informed before making a final decision about a vehicle.

Take care, the Motor Medics Dear Mark,

You never want to guess with head gaskets as they are very expensive to replace but what you are describing is a failure symptom. When coolant flow is disrupted by a head gasket leak, it is the presence of exhaust gases in the coolant that is the cause. A simple test can be done to check for these gases and if any traces are found you know there is an issue with a gasket or something more severe. Once gases are detected a tear down is necessary to determine the exact cause, gasket, block, head, etc.

Dear Motor Medics,

I have what I think to be a very simple question but when I ask others I get as many different answers as the people I ask. I want to know if it is necessary to connect the last jumper cable connection which is always my negative cable to the engine block instead of right to the battery which seems more convenient to me. I have received many different answers and I just want to know what the proper way is. Can you help me Motor Medics? .

Dear Barb,

Great question for the safety of anyone who ever must jump start a car. Many people connect the cables directly to the terminals on both batteries claiming it makes it easier to start and this is extremely dangerous! If your battery cables on the vehicle and jumper cables are both in good shape connecting them properly will work just fine. When you make the last connection of the jumper cables it is normal for the connection to give off a small spark. This spark can easily ignite the hydrogen gas given off by a battery under normal operation and cause an explosion. This explosion can be powerful enough to send sulfuric acid and pieces of battery shrapnel flying towards you injuring you. To prevent this, you need to make the last connection away from the battery which would be the engine block. Always consult your owner's manual.

I have a question about spare tires. I see many new cars not coming with a spare of any kind. When we purchased our latest car, it came this way and in the place of it was a can of tire sealant and an inflator can. The instructions say to use the sealant then if the tire is still low to use the inflator can and use as necessary to reach the nearest place to have it repaired. Why can't they just make a place for the spare? We have had spares in our vehicles as long as I have been driving and they work just fine, although I have never had to use one since our tires are kept in good shape.

Dear Motor Medics,

Please help me out with Cabin Air Filters. I have a 2009 Honda Accord with one and I have to replace it about every six months when the air starts to blow slowly because it gets so clogged with dirt from my gravel road and being parked outside. Do I really need one? None of my cars over the past 30 years had one and they were just fine.

Dear Gale,

Yes, if your vehicle was equipped with one when it was made. Sure, we have seen some people come into our repair shop with a missing filter and their air is working just fine but we have also had some in for repairs that cost as much as \$1000.00 because they decided to run without one. When a system is designed it's either made for one or not. If it's not designed for one, then the sensitive components like air temp sensors and even the moving air doors are made differently so they can handle the dirt load. Adding a bunch of dirt to the system by not having a filter in place just invites trouble so make sure you keep a filter that's clean in place. It's cheap insurance for an expensive system. For others that don't know if they have a filter make sure to find out. A good indication you have one and it's dirty is a foul smell or reduced air flow.

I have a 2020 Chevy and a 2018 Honda, and both have recalls on them. Both cars are running just fine, and I have not experienced any of the issues in the recall that they want to fix because they're crash related, and I've never had a wreck. I did Google one of the recalls and only 2 people have had a problem out of thousands of vehicles so do I really need to get them done or can I just wait and do them if I ever get the time to go to the dealership?

Dear Mark,

Go make that appointment right now and get the recalls done! The manufacturer would not take the time and spend

hicles to save weight and room. Cars have been on this trend for a while now. I think the first one I saw was in a Hybrid and if they had wanted one I don't know where they would have put it. Removing the spare saves weight and every pound you save means a bit more fuel mileage. This combined with other weight savings can make a big impact overall. The tire sealant and inflator can work for smaller leaks but for anything major like a large bolt or other object you will need a tire change to get you going.

Take care, the Motor Medics the money (sometimes millions) to get the vehicle back in to perform a safety recall unless they felt strongly that something could cause you harm. Many recalls for safety are for things that can happen in a crash situation such as air bag recalls and seat belts but even if you are a great driver the other person not always is, and we don't want to see you injured by something you don't have repaired. All safety recalls we have ever seen are done at no cost to you and must be done at the dealership. They do a pretty good job at making the public aware of the recall but getting it in is your part.
