The project will construct a spine road down the center so the industrial park will have access to both Tallevast Road and University Parkway. Passenger vehicle parking will be provided for the employees and tractor trailer parking and loading spaces will be provided for the semi-delivery trucks. Up to 14.6 ac of wetland impacts are proposed in order to plan the facility and over 30 ac of wetland mitigation area set aside to mitigate the proposed impacts.
