

- (3) You will not possess, carry or own any firearm. You will not possess, carry, or own any other weapon without first securing the consent of your Probation Officer.
- (4) You will live without violating the law. A conviction in a court of law shall not be necessary in order for such a violation to constitute a violation of your probation.
- (5) You will not associate with any person engaged in any criminal activity.
- (6) You will not use intoxicants to excess or possess any drugs or narcotics, unless prescribed by a physician. Nor will you visit places where intoxicants, drugs, or other dangerous substances are unlawfully sold, dispensed, or used.
- (7) You will work faithfully at suitable employment insofar as may be possible.
- (8) You will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed to you by the Court or the Probation Officer, and permit your Probation Officers to visit your home, at your place of employment or elsewhere, and you will comply with all instructions your Probation Officer may give you.
- (9) You will submit to random testing as directed by the Probation Officer or the professional staff of the treatment center where he or she is receiving treatment to determine the presence or use of alcohol or controlled substances.
- (10) You will pay fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) per month toward the cost of your Supervision due monthly on the date of sentence. Last payment is due fifteen (15) days prior to termination date.
- (11) You will pay \$1,429.00 in Fines and/or Costs within 11 months.
- (12) You will pay a \$50.00 Cost of Prosecution Fee within 11 months.
- (13) You will pay a \$60.00 State Court Facility Fee within 11 months.
- (14) You will pay Investigative Costs in the amount of \$100.00 to the Bradenton Police Department within 11 months.
- (15) You will attend and complete the ADVANCED DUI Program at State College of Florida (or other equivalent school) and receive a Substance Abuse Evaluation and, if necessary, treatment at a designated authorized DUI Agency within 11 months.
- (16) You will attend and complete a Victim Impact Panel within 11 months.
- (17) Your Driver's License is hereby suspended for a period of 5 years.
- (18) Court orders vehicle Impounded for a period of 30 days to commence within 11 months.
- (19) You will complete 50 hours of Community Service Work within 11 months.
- (20) You will report to the Manatee County Probation Office within 2-business days.
