Reporting to the University Director of Civil Service Support, the Civil Service Tests and Assessment Manager creates and administers valid and legally defensible job-related tests and evaluation strategies in a variety of types and formats for classified civil service title selection, retention, employee development, and performance management functions; ensure that tests and assessments comply with legal obligations, contractual agreements, job title specifications, and professional standards, plus align with University goals; provide guidance and expertise in the design, analysis, and validation of tools and tests created and used in classified personnel assessment and selection; testify as an expert witness in legal proceedings involving civil service examinations; train HR staff and employees on civil service topics. A Bachelor's degree and six years' related experience required. The ideal candidate will have six years' of professional and technical experience with planning, constructing/developing, evaluating and validating large-scale job-related personnel competency assessment and selection tests used for civil service employment in New York State; have knowledge of and experience with applying and interpreting New York State civil service law and New York City personnel rules and regulations.
