Job Description

Primarily, the Candidate will be expected to inspect roadway planting medians and make horticultural recommendations all throughout NYC. Inspections will consist of traveling to and from locations and monitoring various landscape conditions with an emphasis on overall appearance and plant health. Will maintain records and prepare written reports. Also, under supervision, the applicant will work on the Arterial Maintenance herbicide crew. Responsibilities will include: controlling weedy plants along the arterial highway right-of-way within the five boroughs. Candidate will be expected to take responsibility for all tasks related to herbicide application: safety, efficiency, record-keeping, notification, inventory, equipment maintenance and scheduling. In addition to herbicide application work, there will be incidental work with tree planting, turf establishment, manual weed control and general landscape maintenance including snow removal. Candidate will operate and care for hand and power gardening tools and equipment and make necessary operating adjustments; report need for repairs and replacements. Will maintain simple records and prepare written reports. Perform related duties.
