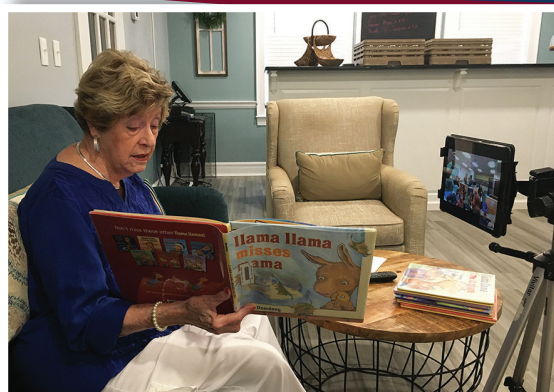

2022 Rotary Peace Conference focuses on unconscious bias

The 2022 Rotary Peace and Conflict Resolution Conference with an emphasis on unconscious bias will be held on May 12 at the Greenville Convention Center. The conference is presented by Rotary District 7750 and the Rotary Club of Greenville.

When we think of bias, we often think of racial and gender bias. However, this conference goes far beyond that. It is about all kinds of biases that are part of our thoughts, words, and ac-

tions everyday with our family, friends, colleagues at work, and others. Biases against those with disabilities, those in poverty and the homeless, those formerly incarcerated, and bias in education and health care will be examined as well as racial and gender bias.

Some may think that bias is in our genes. Is it? Bruce Lipton, a cell biologist and professor of medicine, says "No." In his book, *Biology of Belief*, he says your behavior is 95% due to environment and 5% due to genes. In his study of cell behavior, he has shown that human cells adapt to the environment in which they live. Jessica Sharp, Founder and CEO of Sharp Brain Consulting, says, "If you have a brain, you have a bias."

Brain experts say that our mind is comprised of two interdependent minds:

the conscious mind and the unconscious mind. The conscious mind is the creative mind, a thinking mind, while the unconscious mind is an "autopilot" mind. The unconscious mind will carry out thoughts and actions it has learned from experience and from the environment to which it has been exposed.

These are programmed in our mind, and they have been learned from parents, siblings, friends, from listening and seeing actions of others, reading, watching TV or any other type of communication.

Are you aware of your biases? This is what this conference is about. The conference will focus on breaking down communication barriers caused by bias so that we can learn how to communicate more productively.

I encourage all Rotarians to partici-

pate in this conference. Bring your family. Invite your friends and neighbors. The registration fee is only \$45 which covers a light breakfast, lunch, and two breaks. You can pay registration fees for students to attend when you register as well.

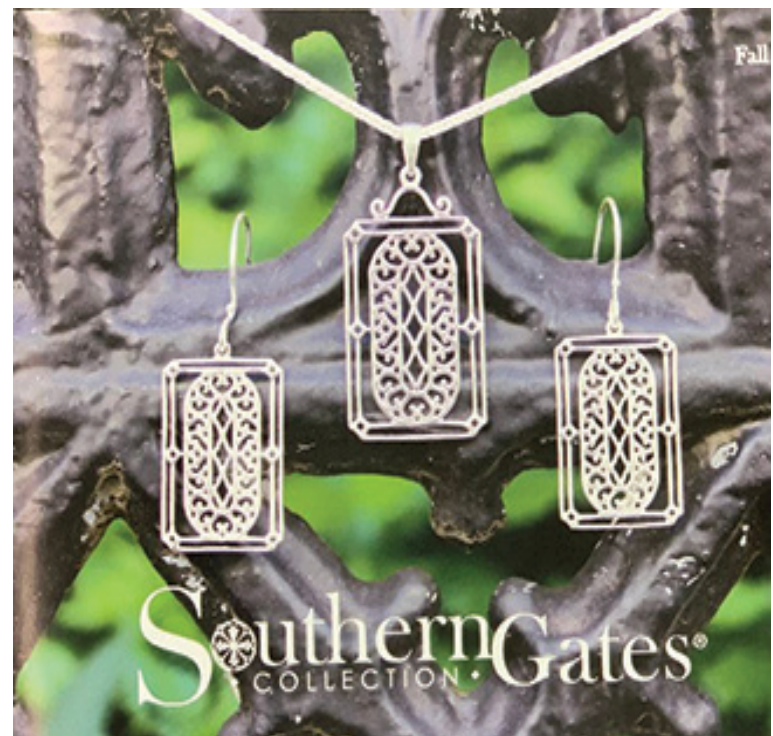

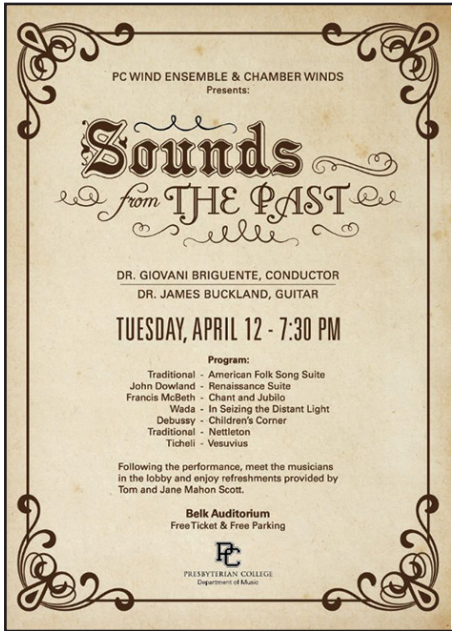

Laurens County Sheriff Don Reynolds spoke to the Clinton Rotary Club April 26 and brought information about the LCSO community service programs. These include Project Lifesaver, Family Assistance, Project SOS, and Christmas for Kids, with a major fund-raiser, the "Jail and Bail" this past Friday (May 6) at the Historic Courthouse on the Laurens Square. The Project SOS (Senior Outreach Services) goals are to educate residents on crime and fraud prevention, provide medical ID cards, ensure living arrangements are safe, speak with residents about community concerns, check on the well-being of participants, and built relationships to form a connection and establish a plan of action should the need arise. The Family Assistance Program exists to aid Laurens County residents in need. This emergency fund has allowed the office to assist with paying for medication, utilities, emergency shelter, and necessities. Project Lifesaver is a rapid response program that aids in locating people who may wander away from their homes. Services are provided to those with Alzheimer's, Autism, Down Syndrome, Dementia etc. - must be formally diagnosed, must be able to wear a bracelet at all times, for Laurens County residents. 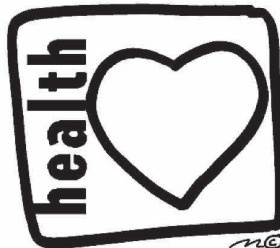

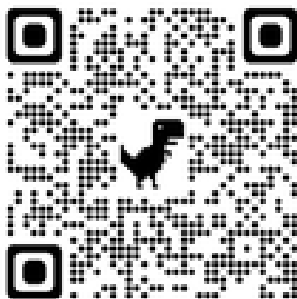

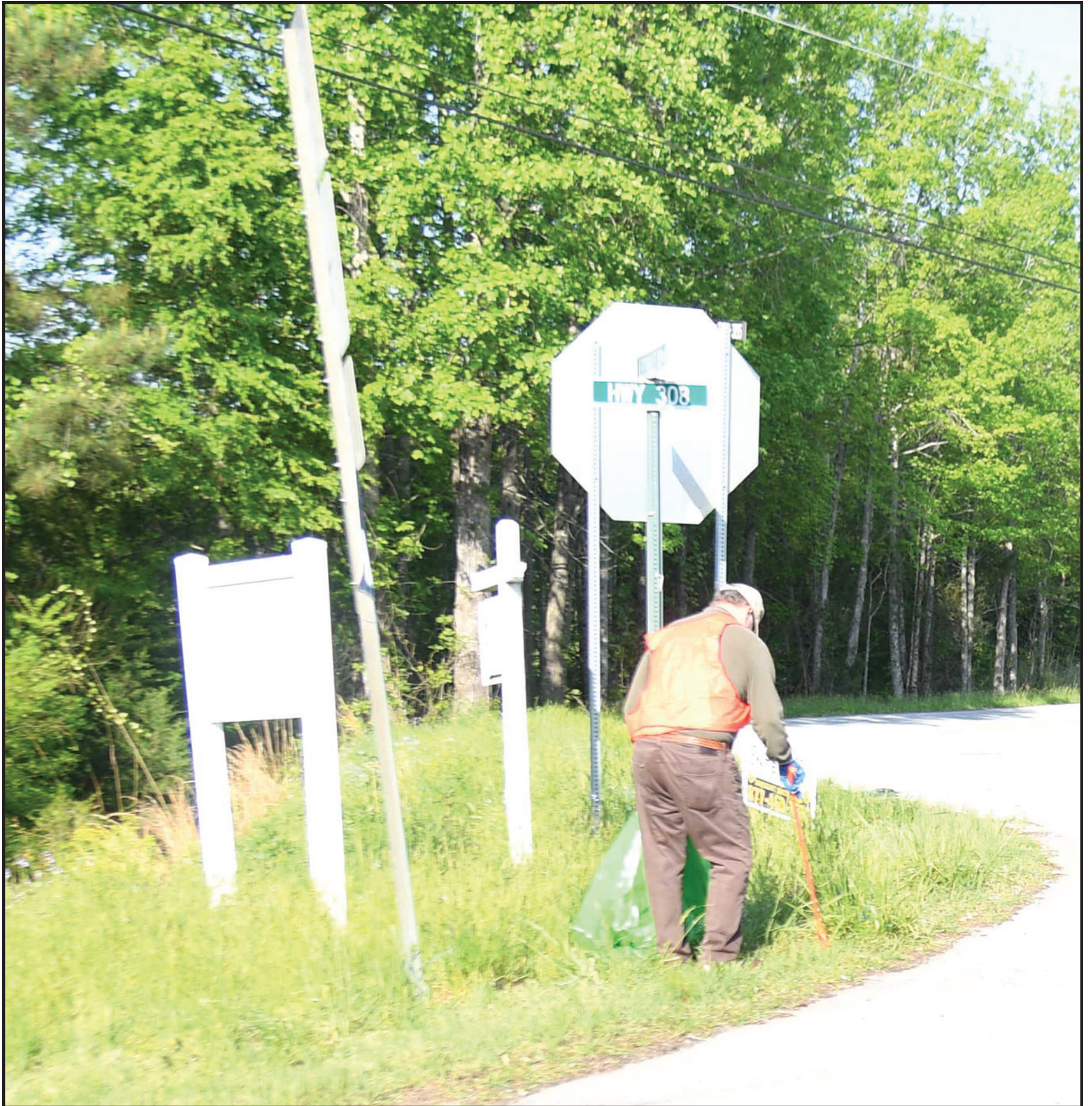
