County asked to help water systems with funding

Water providers face expenses in making sure that local customers have access to water even during extreme conditions, and a local man who represents public utilities asked the Coryell County Commissioners Court to consider funding some of those obligations.

Jason Knobloch, who works for the Texas Rural Water Association but said he was speaking as a concerned local resident, asked county leaders to help local water suppliers meet the cost in ensuring that area residents have access to water even when harsh conditions occur.

He referred to Winter Storm Uri, which resulted in widespread power and water outages in mid-February, as being the type of event which caught many utility companies off guard and caused massive service disruptions.

"That caused a lot of damage and put heavy financial burdens on many water systems," Knobloch said. "Senate Bill 3 requires water providers to come up with emergency plans, and having a backup power generator is one way for water systems to comply."

There are 13 water systems in Coryell County, and in addition to the city-operated utilities, there are nine rural water systems. "On behalf of the rural water systems, I am

asking for assistance with emergency preparedness, for some type of funding," Knobloch said. "It would make a huge difference. There's not just the cost of the generator itself, but also the cost of getting it installed, the maintenance and the parts."

"These systems need to be able to generate enough power to keep water flowing. I know there are also opportunities for grants, but it takes a while and requires going through a lot of paperwork and that can be difficult for small water providers."

"Your financial assistance would really help. There are other counties that are also doing this." Knobloch said Anderson County leaders

provided funding for four generators for four different water utilities.

"They had to evaluate what was critical and how to keep water flowing," he said. "With Uri there were busted pipes because the flow of water had been stopped. Water is critical, so I hope this (funding) will be considered."

Pct. 2 Commissioner Daren Moore asked for action to be taken, and recommended funding designated for other areas, such as the establishment of a public health district and advertising and media expenses, be moved to assist rural water systems. His motion was seconded by Pct. 1 Commissioner

Adding Sparkle to the Season

The Sparkle Box Kindness Project at the Jonesboro Independent School District was prompted by an award-winning holiday book, The Sparkle Box by Julie Hardie.

Jonesboro school librarian, Kim Patterson, presented the idea to the teachers of children from pre-kindergarten through the seventh grade.

In the book, one of the main characters, Sam, can't wait for Christmas and is excited about all of the parties, food and the Christmas presents. One gift has him especially curious - a sparkling silver box on the fireplace mantel.

His parents will only tell him that the Sparkle Box is a special gift they will open together as a family. On Christmas morning, the family finds the Sparkle Box under the Christmas tree with a gift tag that says, "To: Jesus."

Sam discovers that his mother had been writing down random acts of kindness done by the family throughout the season and placing the small cards in the Sparkle Box. When the family opened the box, they shared out loud the gifts they have given to Jesus by performing acts of kindness to help and benefit.

Patterson, and her co-worker, Tommie Necessary, decided to implement the idea of a Sparkle Box into each of the classrooms

through the seventh grade.

Patterson and Necessary distributed the silver boxes along with post-it notes so that students could write down acts of kindness done by individual students, the class as a whole, or a teacher.

The students were instructed that an act of kindness could be done at school, home or in the community. Examples given to the students were helping elderly neighbors, giving toys and clothing to the Care Center, helping in the community, among many other acts of goodness.

Just before Thanksgiving, Patterson read the story to the students so that they would have about 2 1/2 weeks to do acts of kindness. "I collected the sparkle boxes on Dec. 10 from the classrooms. We read all the acts of kindness that were placed in the boxes. We then chose 22 students who had shown the most kindness," Patterson said.

On Dec. 13, the surprise to the chosen students was a celebration in the library.

"The students saw that their boxes were under the tree with gift tags saying, To Jesus," she said. The students then watched the movie "The Star" and shared pizza and Christmas treats.

"The Sparkle Box Kindness Project was special to me for several reasons. First, it helped us focus on the reason for the season, Jesus.

"Second, it encouraged the children to do what Jesus wants us to do which is loving, helping, serving, and being kind to others.

Lastly, when we show kindness, it not only fills the hearts of others, but it fills our own hearts," Patterson said.

Teaching students English

There are 131 students — mostly from Mexico, but some from other locations including Asia and Europe — enrolled in English as a Second Language (ESL) programs in the Gatesville Independent School District.

Julia Martin, the ESL coordinator for GISD, presented an overview of the program during a recent meeting of the district's board of trustees. The state requires that all students in Texas who have a primary language other than English and who are identified as English language learners have an opportunity to participate in either a bilingual or ESL program.

Annual reports update the students' academic progress, proficiency in English and the number of teachers and aides the district has dedicated to working with ESL students.

"We work to make sure the students' cognitive and linguistic needs are being met — it's very thorough," Martin said.

Alaska: "It is cold and dark in Alaska in December. We still go out for recess every day, even if it is zero degrees.

"On December 21st, the sun will rise at 10:14 a.m. and set at 3:41 p.m. That gives us only five hours and 28 minutes of daylight."

The students continued, "We have a lot of wildlife in Alaska. We often need to keep a lookout for moose when we walk to school or play outside. We have three kinds of bears in Alaska: polar bears, grizzly/brown bears and black bears."

Gatesville Primary School principal Mashara Streater commented on the educational impact the project will have on the students.

"The gingerbread man exchange has been a great opportunity for the students in Miss Colson's class to make connections with other kindergarten students around the country. Students in the class are learning about geography (marking the cities on the map), as well as learning about how diverse other schools can be. I'm sure that this is an activity that Miss Colson's students will always remember," Streater said.

Finding the Gingerbread Exchange to be a great success – fun for the children and yet educational, Colson said.

"My class was the only class to do it this year. I decided on a whim to try it out and see if it would be successful.

I hope to continue the idea for next year also and include the other kindergarten classes."

Kyle Matthews, but the process stalled when County Judge Roger Miller did not call for a vote.

Miller disagreed with depleting the funds from some of the other areas, including for the establish-

ment of a health district, which some commissioners have said they oppose. Matthews said he believes such a district would not be in the best interest of local residents, pointing to Bell County and Lubbock as among those who have had to supplement those districts with their own money.

Moore also said he was not im-

pressed with a presentation being made to county leaders about the establishment of such a district for Coryell County. He asked for \$200,000 designated for that purpose to instead be moved entirely to assist rural water systems, as well as other funds designated for advertising and media expenses. Matthews also said he was in favor

of doing that.

Judge Miller declined to do so, which prompted Matthews to ask that an item be placed on the Dec. 28 commissioners court agenda that would replace Miller as the administrator of American Recovery Act funds with County Auditor Ben Roberts.

"It is my belief that the county

auditor should be involved before submitting the grant request to the federal government," Matthews said.

A vote on an item which would designate ARP funding and potentially provide money to rural water systems was tabled, and was set to be considered again at the commissioners court's Dec. 28 meeting.

The program focuses on listening, speaking, reading and writing.

"Several students (were rated as) advanced on listening, reading and writing but beginning on speaking," Martin said. She said the program downgrades a student on their speaking rating if they pause, and that GISD staff were working to

correct that.

As with other educational programs statewide and nationally, COVID-19 delayed development and decreased student attendance overall, but GISD staff are working to close that gap, she said.

An effort is being made to ensure that more district educators are ESL certified. So far, those who have earned ESL certification across each campus include: 13 at the primary school, 28 at the elementary, 27 at the intermediate, 12 at the junior

high and 17 at the high school.

"The test is hard but the district gives incentives (to teachers working to obtain ESL certification)," Martin said. "It gives them time to take the test at Region 12 (Education Service Center in Waco) and it pays for their testing."

An emphasis is made on reaching students at the youngest levels to build a strong language foundation.

"The program's really wonderful," Martin said. "It's not just put-

ting them on a computer or iPad. They have to listen, read, speak and write. It's addressing all four domains there."

The program for students in grades 4-12 is also designed to maximize student achievement.

"It's super amazing — it reaches the kids at their age level. They love it because it's very interesting. It's really a great program."

GISD Superintendent Barrett Polard asked where students enrolled in the program are from.

"Ninety percent are from Mexico, but we have kids from Albania, Vietnam, Cambodia, India, the Philippines, Germany and Spain," Martin said.

Board member Mary Anne Leib asked if most of those entering the program did not know any English.

"Yes, most do," Martin said, adding that she gets to know the children and their families well. "I know them by heart — they are my heart."

Cedar fever season is upon us in Texas

Cedar fever season is upon us once again, complete with runny noses, itchy eyes and general misery. But what exactly is cedar fever, and why is it so insufferable this time of year?

For starters, cedar fever isn't a flu or a virus – it is an allergic reaction to the pollen released by mountain cedar trees. In Texas, the predominant species of mountain cedar is the Ashe juniper.

"Cedar fever is the worst west of I-35, where you have primarily juniper mixed in with oaks and some other species," said Jonathan Motsinger, Texas A&M Forest Service Central Texas Operations Department Head. "And because all of those junipers are producing pollen at the same time, you're going to get a higher concentration of pollen in the air."

This is one of the primary factors contributing to cedar fever – the sheer quantity and density of Ashe junipers in central Texas. According to Karl Flocke, a woodland ecologist for Texas A&M Forest Service, the pollen from

Ashe junipers isn't particularly allergenic or harmful – it's just so concentrated that, even if you aren't generally susceptible to allergies, it could still affect you.

"There are millions of junipers out there all releasing pollen at the same time," said Flocke, "you can't help but breathe it in, and when you do, your body reacts as it would to any perceived threat – it tries to fight it."

Since the pollen is spread by the wind, cedar fever can affect individuals far removed from areas with a high concentration of juniper trees. And the source isn't limited to Ashe junipers: in more eastern parts of the state, there are also eastern red cedars that pollinate around the same time and can induce a similar response from people's auto-immune systems.

Besides the sheer quantity of pollen released, cedar fever is mostly problematic because of when the pollen is released. Most trees pollinate in the spring when many are expecting to have allergies.

Ragweed pollen and mold spores can contribute to allergies in the fall, but very few plants pollinate during the winter. Juniper trees are the exception.

These trees typically begin producing pollen in mid-December, often triggered by colder weather or the passage of a Texas cold front. Pollen production reaches its peak in mid-January, before slowly tapering off toward the beginning of March, just in time for oak pollen and other spring allergens to start up.

"Immediately before and after a cold front it gets very dry and windy and the pressure changes very rapidly," said Flocke. "This triggers the opening of pollen cones and the release of the pollen grains. When you see the pollen billowing off a tree that has just 'popped,' or opened its cones, it looks very similar to smoke coming from a wildfire."

While this creates for some fascinating imagery, it can also lead to some serious misery. For people new to the central Texas region, or unfamiliar with cedar fever as a whole, it can also lead to confusion since the pollination period of mountain cedar trees is smack dab in the middle of cold and flu season – or a global pandemic.

It's not uncommon for people experiencing cedar fever to mistake their symptoms as a cold or the seasonal flu, especially given the variety of symptoms triggered by cedar fever. These include fatigue, sore throat, runny nose, partial loss of smell and – believe it or not – some people actually do run a slight fever. However, if your fever is higher than 101.5F, then pollen likely isn't the cause.

There are a few symptoms of cedar fever that are not linked to coronavirus or the flu though, like itchy, watery eyes, blocked nasal passages and sneezing. But there is one symptom that, according

to Flocke, should steer you clear.

"Typically, mucous from allergies is clear and runny while other infections lead to thicker colored mucous," Flocke said.

You can treat cedar fever by taking allergy medications and antihistamines, but you should consult with your physician or health care professional before taking new medications. You can also try and anticipate the pollen by tuning in to your local news station, many of which will give you the pollen count and can predict when it's going to be a particular pollen heavy day. On those days, it's smart to keep windows and doors closed, to limit the amount of time you spend outdoors and to change air conditioning filters in your car and in your home.

Removing juniper trees from your property isn't recommended primarily because the pollen is airborne and—since they often wait to release their pollen until it's cold, dry and windy—that pollen can blow for miles. It's

also important to note that only male juniper trees release pollen.

"The male trees have pollen cones, and the female trees have berry-like cones, which are very inconspicuous, but that's what is pollinated from the male trees," said Motsinger.

While junipers are notorious for releasing their fever-inducing allergens, they also have immense health benefits. Their berries, for instance, are used to make medicines and oils that can treat a variety of ailments, from an upset stomach to a snake bite. They are also high in nutrition and vitamins, providing a sustainable source of food for wildlife and soil enrichment, and they grow in a terrain that isn't particularly hospitable to other species of tree. Most importantly, though, they provide the mental, physical and environmental health benefits of trees and forests everywhere.

Ultimately, mountain cedars are really only singled out for the unusual time of

year in which they pollinate.

"Many trees rely on airborne pollination," said Flocke. "In other parts of the country, folks suffer from pine or elm allergies. Here in the springtime, there is so much oak pollen collecting on surfaces that I have to wash my car's windshield daily just to see out of it."

While cedar fever might sound and seem particularly hostile, Ashe junipers are really just a species like any other, feeling out the conditions and waiting for the perfect moment to release their pollen in order to set their offspring up for success come springtime.

Holiday Safety Tips



- Wash your hands frequently when handling food
- Keep raw meat away from fresh produce
- Use separate cutting boards, plate, and utensils for uncooked and cooked meats to avoid cross-contamination
- Use a food thermometer to make sure meat is cooked to a safe temperature
- Refrigerate hot or cold leftover food within two hours of being served
- When storing turkey, cut the leftovers in small pieces so they will chill quickly
- Leftovers are safe for three to four days when properly refrigerated

Holiday safety is an issue that burns brightest from late November to mid-January, when families gather, parties are scheduled and travel spikes.

Following is tried-and-true advice to ensure your family remains safe and injury-free throughout the season.

Candles and Fireplaces

Use of candles and fireplaces, combined with an increase in the amount of combustible, seasonal decorations in many homes during the holidays, means more risk for fire. The National Fire Protection Association reports that one-third of home decoration fires are started by candles and that two of every five decoration fires happen because the decorations are placed too close to a heat source.

- Place candles where they cannot be knocked down or blown over and out of reach of children

- Keep matches and lighters up high and out of reach of children in a locked cabinet

- Use flameless, rather than lighted, candles near flammable objects

- Don't burn trees, wreaths or wrapping paper in the fireplace

- Use a screen on the fireplace at all times when a fire is burning
- Never leave candles or fireplaces burning unattended or when you are asleep
- Check and clean the chimney and fireplace area at least once a year

Turkey Fryers

Be alert to the dangers if you're thinking of celebrating the holidays by frying a turkey. The Consumer Product Safety Commission reports there have been 107 turkey-fryer related fires, burns or other injuries since 2004, and \$5.2 million in property damage losses from these incidents.

NSC discourages the use of turkey fryers at home and urges those who prefer fried turkey to seek out professional establishments or consider using an oil-less turkey fryer. If you must fry your own turkey, follow all U.S. Fire Administration turkey fryer guidelines.

Food Poisoning Is No Joke

Keep your holidays happy by handling food safely. The foodsafety.gov website from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services provides some valuable holiday food safety tips:

It's Better to Give Safely

Gifts and toys should inspire joy, not cause injuries. Thousands of children are seriously injured in toy-related incidents every year. Avoid safety hazards while gifting with these tips from the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission:

- Toys are age-rated for safety, not for children's intellect and physical ability, so be sure to choose toys in the correct age range
- Choose toys for children under 3 that do not have small parts which could be choking hazards
- For children under 10, avoid toys that must be plugged into an electrical outlet
- Be cautious about toys that have button batteries or magnets, which can be harmful or fatal if swallowed
- When giving scooters and other riding toys, give the gift of appropriate safety gear, too; helmets should be worn at all times, and they should be sized to fit

Christmas is Here

"The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. There is a natural tendency to believe that Christmas comes but once a year. This misconception is based on the calendar, which gives it only one day of the year. Some of us do a bit better by celebrating the season of Christmas, perhaps treating everything from roughly Thanksgiving to the New Year as being part of the Christmas season. But we should remember that Christmas is really a celebration of God's incarnation. God literally came to be with us here on earth, and that is something that can and should be celebrated all year long. And while it is noteworthy that God came to earth in very humble form, a helpless baby born in a manger, focusing on Jesus's birth misses the wider context of the incarnation. God's physicality as a human being highlights the divine aspect of human nature (we all have the spirit of God within us), but understanding Jesus as the second person of God also raises the stature of the natural world. The physical world is imbued with divine importance by God's incarnation, and we should consider that this entire world is a gift from God. Perhaps that is the true meaning of Christmas! — Christopher Simon

Munday also took part in the ceremony by placing a wreath in honor of the U.S. Army near the assembly area alongside wreaths representing the six other branches of military service and prisoners of war.

The ceremony, which was narrated by 1st Lt. Mason Prewitt from the TX-391 Dallas Composite Squadron, Civil Air Patrol, featured a flyover by the Service Air Corps,

the singing of the National Anthem and the Irish Blessing by the Good Times Chorus out of Arlington, Texas, and the presentation of the U.S. National Colors by cadets from both the TX 391 and Black Sheep Squadrons, Civil Air Patrol.

National Wreaths Across America Day is held annually mid-December at more than 2,500 locations across the U.S., at sea and abroad

with a goal of laying a wreath at the gravesite of each veteran.

"Every headstone on these grounds represents a single veteran—an American hero—who selflessly served our nation," Richardson said.

"It is your presence that means so much to the families of those whose loved ones rest in peace on these hallowed grounds."

Texas Parks Ambassador program accepting applications for Central Texas cohort

After a two-year hiatus, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) will re-launch the Texas State Parks Ambassador Program in early 2022.

Texas State Parks Ambassadors are a diverse group of conservation-minded young adult volunteers between the ages of 18 and 30 that

are paired with a Texas State Park to help foster a new generation of outdoor stewards. The program seeks to attract a younger audience to Texas State Parks to continue the conservation of Texas' wild things and wild places for years to come.

Those interested in joining the program must first

fill out their application, indicate the parks they would like to be paired with, and then the top candidates will be selected for an interview. The final group that are selected as Texas State Parks Ambassadors will then be required to attend Ambassador Leadership Training before beginning their

six-month ambassadorship. During that time, ambassadors will complete 40 hours of hands-on service, community outreach, and social media projects for their parks.

The five-day Ambassador Leadership Training for the new cohort of Central Texas Ambassadors will take place in March 2022. During

the training, new Ambassadors will be introduced to park interpretation, outdoor education programming like Project Wild, provided tips on how to be a successful Ambassador, and will also get to participate in activities like kayaking, backpacking, mountain biking, and more.

Applications for Central

Ambassadors will close on Jan. 26 and must be submitted online. The six-month term for new Ambassadors will begin April 1 and run through Oct. 1.
