TWENTY YEARS AGO (2003)

Niemeier had received an accounting degree from Baylor University and a law degree from Georgetown University in Washington, D.C.

Thomas Bone was named "Teacher of the Month" by the Gatesville Lions Club. He was a sixth-grade math teacher at Gatesville Intermediate School. Bone had attended the University of Texas and the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor.

Larry Secrest was named "Firefighter of the Year" at a banquet held at the Gatesville Volunteer Fire Department. Secrest joined the department in September 1995 and earned an advanced certification as a firefighter.

Mason Jones, age 8, of Gatesville, brought home a seven-point buck from the Jones and Son Ranch in Co-

ryell County. Jones shot the big deer with a .243 from about 120 yards. He is listed as the son of Philip and Hollie Jones.

1 ½ lbs. ground beef
¼ c. tomato soup (optional)
Onions to taste
¼ c. ketchup
Salt, pepper, savory salt
3 T. brown sugar
1 c. cracker crumbs
¼ tsp. nutmeg
1 c. milk
1 tsp. dry mustard
1 egg, slightly beaten
little water
