1 ½ lbs. ground beef ¼ c. tomato soup (optional)

Onions to taste ¼ c. ketchup

Salt, pepper, savory salt

3 T. brown sugar

1 c. cracker crumbs

¼ tsp. nutmeg

1 c. milk

1 tsp. dry mustard

1 egg, slightly beaten little water

Mix beef, onions, seasonings, cracker crumbs, milk, eggs and tomato soup and place in loaf pan. Mix remaining ingredients and pour over top of meat loaf. Bake at 350 for 1 hour.
