

A house full of little houses

hen I stepped onto the porch of Nancy Lane's house in Brady, I knew it was going to be an interesting visit. The porch was decorated with flags, windmills, signs, and comfortable furniture that provided a warm and welcoming atmosphere. I was there to interview her about her dollhouses. She makes them.

"I live with them," she says. "They're all over my house. I build them from scratch.

This clever woman, an accomplished artist, makes items for inside the houses.

"This chandelier is made from a ladies' sandal. I use a dental floss box to act as a water container for the commode. I took a bird cage and turned it into a gazebo."

She has dollhouses that are log cabins, farmhouses, even recreational vehicles. Nancy has 15 dollhouses inside her house and more in a barn outside. They're large. Most are four feet long with two or three stories. One is six feet long. They all have several rooms, all completely furnished. She took the roof off one to show me the inside.

"Over here is the music room. There's a bedroom, and this one has a game room with a pool table. I'll put the roof back on so you can see the rooftop patio."

Some houses are on turntables so when you turn them around you have a completely different view. She showed me one that was just a regular house on one side but when you turned it around vou noticed it is decorated for Christmas.

"That's my Christmas house. At Christmas time I just turn it around."

Almost all the houses have wrap-around porches.

The upstairs ones have balconies. In building her houses, she uses a scale of one inch representing one foot.

She took me into a room so she could show me what she calls a room box.

"This little room on the shelf here is a representation of this room that we're in. I don't know why I did it, ideas just pop into my head. I just go with it. When I get an idea if I don't do something with it right then I lose it. Use it or lose it."

She is serious about building dollhouses and attends workshops and showcases.

"Doll houses are big in the northeast but not so much in Texas. I'm working on one right now called the Glanville. The designer of this dollhouse used the design of the Rosemont mansion in Waxahachie."

She buys some items for her dollhouses. She showed me a rug.

"This is an actual dollhouse vintage rug. It cost nearly a hundred dollars. Doll housing is not cheap."

Growing up, Nancy had 100 dolls. Her daddy built her a big dollhouse that she played with in the garage. She still has it.

Whatever happened to...

20 YEARS AGO (2003)
