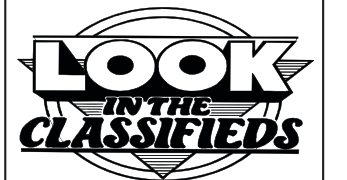

The Evant Volunteer Fire Department will host a barbeque fundraiser during the car show for the community to enjoy.

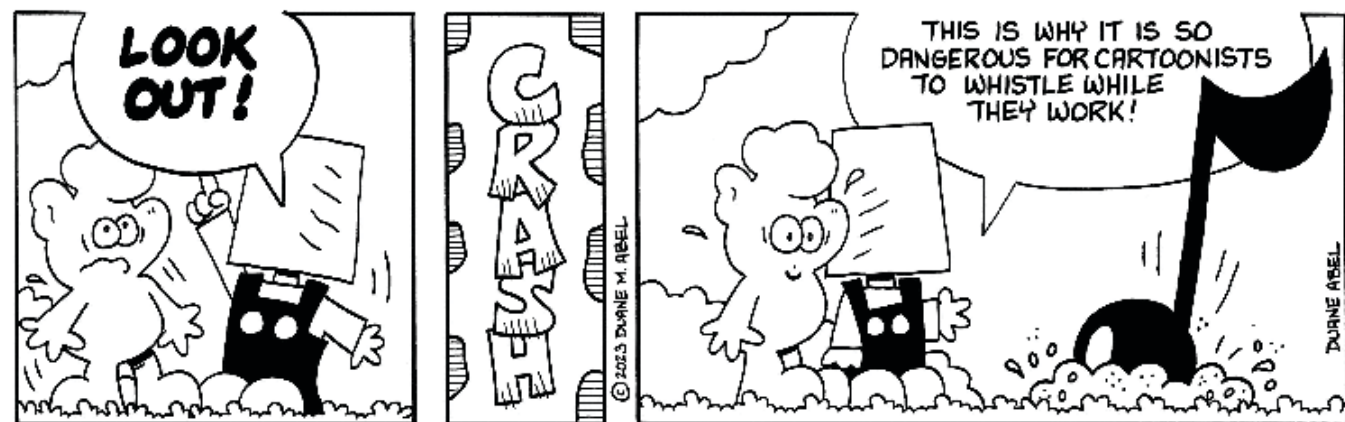
Participants of the car
