



Being a part of the Gatesville community means everything

Being a part of the local community and supporting neighbors is very important to this year's Chamber of Commerce Ambassador of the Year, Diana Barnett.

More than twenty years ago when her employer asked Diana Barnett to transfer to Gatesville to become the Internet Sales Manager at the local Ford dealership, she was excited about the opportunity, but she had no idea what the local community would be like. As the single mother of four boys, one of them with special needs, she was anxious to see if her new home would be a good place to raise her children and if her family would fit in.

Before she committed to the transfer, she drove to town to see what Gatesville was all about. When she stopped at a local restaurant the waitress who served her made a big first impression.

"She was friendly and outgoing and just as sweet as she could be," Barnett said, "She told me the entire town supported the schools and the kids. Her enthusiasm and friendliness made a big impression on me."

Barnett moved to Gatesville from Killeen and found everything the waitress had told her about her new home was truthful. At work, she would meet customers, transact business, and become friends. Then the customer would send their friend or family member to do business. Her children transitioned well into school, and she found support and kindness everywhere she turned.

Eventually, Barnett got remarried to Ronald "Cowboy" Barnett and started the Cowboy Real Estate Team. Unfortunately, Diana's mother developed some serious health issues, which caused her to be away from home and her business for periods of time, but her neighbors and friends were always there to help.

"I would be out of town for a day or two to take care of my mother, and a real estate customer would call me to see a house and I would have to explain why I was gone," Barnett said. "People would never complain and would simply tell me to take care of my mom, and to let them know when I got back. They understood and would wait on me. I had friends and members of the community who would reach out to me, check on me, and make sure I was making it ok. It is the best part of a small town. Here, everyone knows you, where you go and what you do. They want to support and help."

Being part of the Chamber Ambassador Program is simply an opportunity for Barnett to give back to the community and to help local business grow and prosper.

"I know what Gatesville means to me and the support they have given me. I love being able to do the same for others," Barnett said.

Coffee Saloon off to a great start as New Business of the Year

hen the Coffee Saloon opened six months ago, the young owners never imagined they would receive the New Business of the Year award from the Gatesville Chamber of Commerce.

Jennifer Considine had worked as a barista while attending college, and the love of being part of a coffee shop stuck with her. When she and her husband Robert were quarantined at home due to the COVID epidemic they began talking about different business possibilities and their discussion eventually evolved into the possibility of opening a mobile coffee shop. Soon, "The Coffee Saloon" was born.

"I always wanted to open a coffee shop and when we began looking, a coffee trailer sort of fell into our laps at a really good price. It had been set up as a coffee shop for another company. Sometimes, things just seem to work out," Considine said.

Jennifer's husband Robert had grown up in Gatesville, and the young couple and their two children had confidence the community would embrace their new business.

"Our business is Veteranowned as my husband is a member of the National Guard and has been deployed to the border,' Cosidine said. "Robert graduated from Gatesville High and his mother taught school here. The community response has been awesome with people writing reviews and encouraging us, telling us we were doing a good job."

So how does it feel to win such a prestigious award from the Chamber? "It told me the path we

were taking was working and it was the right path," Considine said. "We are so grateful for everything the chamber has done for us. They advertised and promoted us, helped us find events to work, and gave us the opportunity to be a part of the community. This community has embraced our business and we could not ask for a better community to be a part of."

The Coffee Saloon is open from 6:30 a.m. until noon, Monday through Friday, and is located in front of Vintage Royalty on Highway 36. They offer lemonades. a wide variety of teas and coffees, both hot and iced as well as numerous flavors. No one will ever get bored with the menu as Jennifer states: "We change the menu monthly and soon we will begin selling food."
