Chicken Rochambeau

- 8 boned chicken breasts
- 1 c. red cooking wine
- salt and pepper
- 2 c. chicken stock
- flour
- 1 T. Worcestershire sauce
- 1 ½ sticks butter
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 c. minced green onions
- dash cayenne pepper
- 1 tsp. minced garlic
- 3 T. flour
- 1 c. fresh mushrooms, sliced

Season chicken with salt and pepper and dust with flour. Brown quickly in hot butter. Remove from pan and place in baking dish. Add onion, garlic, and mushrooms to frying pan. Sauté 5 minutes. Stir in flour. Add liquids and seasoning. Cool for 5 minutes, stirring. Pour over chicken. Cover and bake at 375 about one hour.
