

The boards propel their operators forward and above the water using an eFoil fin, relying on electric power instead of manual power or wind. They run on a rechargeable lithium battery and create no emissions or noise.

Speeds are controlled

by a Bluetooth-connected hand remote and riders can go upwards of 25 mph on a two-hour charge.

"It's a new and exciting way to experience the North Woods," said Eibner.

WalkAbout stocks Paddle North utility docks made with durable materials for floating or slipping and sliding. The docks are even safe for dogs.

The store also offers a selection of lifeiackets for all members of the family, including the family dog, as well as carries many accessories for water activities and camping.

WalkAbout provides demos of all recreational water toys.

"It's our try-before-youbuy commitment," said the Eibners.

Jessica said WalkAbout's trained and experienced staff is ready to assist guests for a pleasant shopping experience.

Vintage steam train to provide rides to Laona's Camp 5 Museum

The Lumberjack Special Steam Train is again providing rides to the Camp 5 Museum in Laona for the 2024 summer season.

This year marks the 56th anniversary of the operation of the 1916 Vulcan steam engine carrying visitors to the Camp 5 Museum complex. U.P. waterfalls provide scenic views for guests

The Upper Peninsula (U.P.) of Michigan is home to more than 300 waterfalls, with many of them being a hit for visitors. Several are located about an hour or less from the Eagle River area. Almost all require hiking to reach, but there are paths to some of the most popular falls. The best time to see them is in the spring when even the smallest falls roar to life, but they are beautiful year-round. Five U.P. waterfalls that are a short drive from Eagle River include Bond Falls, Agate Falls, O Kun de Kun Falls, Gorge Falls and Potawatomi Falls, Bond Falls is in the western U.P. on Bond Falls Road east of Paulding, Mich., on the Middle Branch of the Ontonagon River, This is the most impressive waterfall in Michigan with the possible exception of Tah Quamenon Falls. The main drop is 40 feet high and 100 plus feet wide. Above the main falls are a series of cascades and rapids that must drop a total of 20 feet. The water level is controlled by a dam and a steady flow over the falls is maintained for scenic reasons. Bond Falls is a Michigan State Scenic Site. The site was renovated in about 2003. The old parking area was upstream of the falls and a steep concrete stairway (still used by many) led to the base of the falls. The new parking area is near the base of the falls and a level boardwalk leads hikers to prime views of the falls. A trail on the east side of the falls remains wild with some steep rocky climbs.

Other trails go off into

the woods and there are campsites nearby at Bond Falls Flowage. Agate Falls, also on the Middle Branch of the Ontonagon River, is another Michigan State Scenic Site located 6.5 miles east of Bruce Crossing, Mich., on Highway 28. There is parking at Joseph F. Oravec Roadside Park just past the bridge over the Ontonagon River. This is one of the largest and most impressive waterfalls in Michigan, dropping about 40 feet. The provided trails and overlooks are somewhat limited. With some effort, hikers can get down to the river to get some very good views of the falls. There is also an old railroad bridge over the falls that is now part of a snowmobile trail. O Kun de Kun Falls, named after an Ojibwe chief, is one of the largest of the

waterfalls in Ontonagon County and is located on the Baltimore River. The trailhead to the falls is located on the east side of Highway 45 about 8 miles north of Bruce Crossing. There are signs for the parking area. The trail to the falls is part of the North Country Trail. It is a mile-plus hike to O Kun de Kun Falls and there are no fences or signs. While it is not as large as Bond or Agate Falls, it is just as scenic and far wilder. It drops about 25 feet. The waterfall is also unusual in that it is an actual plunge fall. Before hikers reach the main falls, they will see a smaller 10-foot plunge upstream but should keep going as the real falls are just a short distance downstream. The trail crosses a suspension bridge below the falls. Because the width

of the falls varies wildly depending on water levels, the Baltimore River can get pretty thin in summer months. Gorge Falls is named for the deep and narrow gorge above and below the falls and is part of Black River Scenic Byway waterfalls. It is also one of the easier waterfalls to visit, being only a short distance from the parking area. There are a fair number of stairs to the falls overlook. It is only a short walk upstream to see Potawatomi Falls. The Black River Scenic Byway starts north of Highway 2 near Bessemer, Mich. There are signs on Highway 2. Gorge Falls is about 14.5 miles north of Highway 2. The scenic area is on the right and is clearly marked. Potawatomi Falls drops 30 feet and is just upstream of Gorge Falls, and is reached

from the same parking area. Potawatomi is the name of one of the native tribes. This waterfall is wheelchair-accessible.

In low water, the waterfall is segmented with

most of the water going to the right. In high water, the river covers the entire rock separating the two segments with a sheet of whitewater.
