Sweet treats galore on the menu at Tremblay's shop downtown

If the aroma of chocolate is not enough to draw those wandering the streets of downtown Eagle River into Tremblay's Sweet Shop, the sight of workers forming piles of fudge into neat loaves often is.

Candy lovers of all ages have headed to Tremblay's for more than 30 years. Originally Zimplemann's Soda Fountain, Tremblay's offers a variety of treats made right in the store.

Those passing by can see fudge and peanut brittle being made through the windows at the front of the store. Employees are often stirring large pots for a curious and hungry audience. Although Tremblay's specialty is fudge, the sweet shop has many kinds of chocolate treats including turtles, hand-dipped chocolates and chocolate clusters.

Fudge balls are made in chocolate, peppermint-chocolate, peanut butter, maple and vanilla flavors.

Tremblay's offers 12 flavors of fudge including cookies and cream, and peanut butter-chocolate. Freshly made English toffee can be found at the store as well as sea monsters, both of which are available in milk and dark chocolate.

The store offers a wide selection of candies. Many flavors of saltwater taffy, and cashew and peanut brittle are favorites. Three flavors of almond bark are also available.

In addition, caramel sea salt balls and Oreo[™] delights are plentiful.

According to manager Rick Behrens, Prime Choice is Eagle River's one-stop shop for fresh cut USDA prime and top choice beef, all-natural antibiotic-free pork, and free-range poultry, as well as premium seafood.

Prime Choice carries a frozen selection of 100% grass-fed beef and select varieties of free-range and certified organic Smart Chicken, as well as their own signature smoked meats.

"Prime Choice focuses on quality and taste, while still being comparable in price to area grocers," said Behrens. "We freshcut only the finest USDA prime and top choice quality steaks and roasts, hand-trimmed to our customers' order and satisfaction." Behrens added that customers are amazed at the quality and appearance of a hand-cut, hand-trimmed piece of meat.

"Everyone likes their steak cut a little differently, and you just can't get that type of thing from precut showcase steaks," he said. "We strive to be sure our customers walk away happy, and return with their friends."

Prime Choice features its own lean ground sirloin every day, sold fresh by the pound while supplies last.

Visitors can also find other varieties of ground meats in the frozen section, like juicy ground chuck, and many varieties of burger patties including the special Butcher's Blend beef patty, which incorporates a blend of three tender cuts of beef ground together to make a juicy, tasty burger.

Customers can also buy the Mushroom and Swiss burger patty, which has fresh mushrooms and creamy Swiss cheese mixed right in.

"All of our ground beef is made fresh on the premises, not bought from another processor," said Behrens. "We feel that our freshground product makes for excellent grilling, especially our famous cranberry-bacon burger, along with bacon burgers and bacon-cheddar burgers, which have bacon from our own smokehouse blended right into the mix for a unique flavor," noted Behrens.

"Always be on the watch for new items we've added," continued Behrens. "We are always toying around with new recipes, checking out newly trending items, as well as getting new ideas from our customers and crew at the market. Be on the lookout for more to come!"

Recent additions include the "All American" brat, a red, white, and blue brat with smoked gouda inside. An all-beef summer sausage was added to complement the current sausage varieties, as well as an expanded line of grass-fed, natural venison products.

"Our market produces an authentic Italian sausage (hot or mild), Chorizo sausage, fresh Polish sausage, and sauerkrautstuffed Polish sausage," said Behrens. In addition, five different flavors of pork breakfast sausages are made in patties, links, and in bulk.

Bratwurst are available fresh (on a rotating schedule) or frozen, and include their original bratwurst, onion, jalapeno and cheddar, garlic, cheddar, jalapeno, sauerkraut, cranberry, blueberry, triple berry, mushroom and Swiss, bacon and cheddar, cheesy onion beer brat, and wild rice varieties.

They also produce a beef bratwurst, chicken fajita bratwurst, a buffalo blue cheese chicken brat, and a turkey bratwurst as added options for customers.

"Be sure to try the famous cranberry brats, our top-selling flavored brat and customer favorite," said Behrens.

The popular cranberry brat is featured at Eagle River's annual Cranberry Fest event every October.

The PGA has rated the course to a slope of 129 from the blue tees. Marquis noted that the course is challenging but fair, and added that Big Stone is the "perfect venue" for new or advanced golfers. Three additional sets of tees are available including white, gold and red sets.

Marquis has been giving lessons at Big Stone Golf Course since 2020. She has been teaching golf for more than 45 years, and has won numerous awards.

In 2022, Marquis was named one of the Top-50 LPGA Teachers in the country. She offers individual lessons and clinics, in addition to classes for new golfers. Classes are available for women, men and juniors.

"Mondays with Patti" is open to all women golfers, regardless of ability. Classes are \$25 per person and run on Mondays from 5 to 7 p.m. Monday, July 1, will be the only date this summer when this class

will not run. Additionally, a junior camp will run on Wednesdays in July from 10 a.m. until noon. Patrons can check the

website or Facebook for exact dates. The cost is \$125 per student. Six different golf leagues are also available for the public to join, including men's and

women's leagues, men's and women's senior leagues, a couples league and a men's individual senior league.

With seating available for people inside the air conditioned clubhouse and out on the patio, golfers can meet up with family and friends before or after a round of golf. A late afternoon setting affords many deer sightings of the numerous fawns born on the course, according to Marquis. The clubhouse patio has views of the course, the




