Director of Campus Safety and Security (Potsdam, NY)

Position Summary: The Director of CSS ensures that a safetyoriented and community- and prevention-based approach is taken into consideration in all work that is carried out by the department. This relies on building and maintaining productive relationships with campus and community constituents.

Minimum qualifications: A bachelor's degree is required. 5-7 years of experience in safety and security or law enforcement in a management position. 2-3 years of experience working on community outreach and diversity, equity, and incluse on. 1-2 years of experience with Emergency Management.

Lead Paramedic Instructor (Potsdam, NY)
