Teams to watch on your schedule: We start out the year with Bishop Neumann and FCEMF. Both teams

A rival conference team to watch is Milford who is returning key players with experience. Towards the end of the year we come across Freeman who will push us and challenge us to play our best ball.
As a first-year head coach, what are your goals for this season?
How would you describe your coaching philosophy?: My goal for this season is to focus on changing the culture of Centennial softball. Each girl has come up with an intangible at the beginning of each week that they will focus on for the entire week. On Fridays we talk about those intangibles and vote as a team if that player met their intangible that week. This helps hold the girls accountable and work towards changing the culture.
Another goal I have is to do everything I can to help each player get 1% better each day by creating relationships with each player and learning about their learning style. I have mentioned to them that at the end of the day the win-loss record doesn't mean anything if we haven't gotten better.
The way I will describe my coaching philosophy is if we practice 110% and mess up, that's fine. I would rather see them mess up giving it their all then mess up giving 50%. My philosophy is getting the fear of failure out of their head and to go out and play with everything they have, not just for themselves, but for everyone around them. I have preached to the girls that my job is to help them improve their skills on the field but also teach them life lessons throughout the time I have them. It is my job to prepare them for the real-world and have their backs every step of the way.
