ORDINANCE NO. 02-15-2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF MELROSE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1989-1-A, AS AMENDED, AND ADOPTED BY REFERENCE AS CHAPTER 153 OF THE CITY OF MELROSE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REZONE PARCEL NO. 66.36440.0000 FROM R-2, RESIDENTIAL TO I, INDUSTRIAL

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes Section 462.357 permits cities to adopt zoning ordinances for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare; and WHEREAS, by application dated January 5, 2024 Mike Youso submitted a request for the rezoning of Parcel No. 66.36440.0000 located between Kraft Drive SW and Interstate 94 from R-2, Residential to I, Industrial; and WHEREAS, following notice and hearing as required by law, the Melrose Planning and Zoning Commission has adopted findings and conclusions recommending the rezoning of Parcel 66.36440.0000 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MELROSE, MINNESOTA CONCURS WITH THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE MELROSE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. The Melrose Planning and Zoning Commission's

findings and conclusions dated January 29, 2024 recommending the rezoning of Parcel 66.36440.0000 are hereby accepted and approved. Section 2. City of Melrose Zoning Ordinance No. 1989-1-A, as amended, adopted by reference as Chapter 153 of the City of Melrose Code of Ordinances, is amended as follows: The real estate described below is reclassified from R-2, Residential to I, Industrial: The West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (W1/2 NW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 3, Township 125 North, Range 33 West, less those parts thereof condemned or purchased by the State of Minnesota for Highway purposes and less those parts thereof part of any road or highway.
