3. **You must respond
to each claim.** The *Answer*
is your written response to

disagree with each paragraph
of the *Complaint*. If you
believe the Plaintiffs should
not be given everything they
asked for in the *Complaint*,

you must say that in your
Answer.

4. **SERVICE: You may
lose your case if you do not
send a written response
to the Plaintiffs.** If you do
not serve a written *Answer*
within 21 days, you may lose
this case by default. You will
not get to tell your side of the
story. If you choose not to
respond, the *Plaintiffs* may
be awarded everything they

ORDINANCE No. 2024-819**

The following is the official summary of Ordinance No. 2024-819 approved by the Sauk Rapids City Council on July 22, 2024:

AN INTERIM ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON THE PERMITTING AND SITING OF BATTERY ENERGY STORAGE SYSTEMS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAUK RAPIDS. It is the intent and effect of this Ordinance to prohibit new Battery Energy Storage Systems projects until the City of Sauk Rapids can study the effects of such projects and ensure that Battery Energy Storage Systems projects do not restrict the ability to grow and expand.
