A. Sauk Rapids Liquor Update-Tom Boulton, Liquor Operations Manager

Tom Boulton provided an update on the ongoings of the City's municipal liquor store, Sauk Rapids Liquor. Boulton said that sales were down \$1,000 in 2024 compared to the previous year, which is the first time in the last thirteen years that sales have been down. Boulton said that although sales were down slightly in 2024, profits were still up. He credited profits being up to various buying strategies. THC has continued to grow in demand since it was first introduced as a product in the store in 2024.

Boulton discussed how a new trend that they are seeing is more demand for non-alcohol (NA) beverages, especially with craft beers. Boulton said that NA beverages and THC are what is most driving the market right now. Boulton discussed attending Minnesota Municipal Bev-

erage Association (MMBA) Day at the Capital. He said that liquor in grocery doesn't seem to be a high priority item this legislative session. Boulton noted that he is more concerned for liquor in convenience stores than liquor in grocery. B. 2025 Sauk Rapids Citizen of the Year Nominations Due April 14th Ross Olson stated that nominations are now being accepted for the 2025 Sauk Rapids Citizen of the Year. Nomination forms can be found online or at Sauk Rapids City Hall. Nomi-

nations are due April 14th. Olson stated that the plan would be to recognize the 2025 Sauk Rapids Citizen of the Year at the April 28th City Council meeting. 12. Other Council Items and Communications

Councilperson Seamans noted that the APO has approved a grant to the City of Sauk Rapids for the Mayhew Lake Road Trail Extension. The funding comes from the federal government. She thanked the staff who participated in the application process. Councilperson Seamans said that the City of Sauk Rapids will be receiving \$346,223.00 for this project.

Scott Hedlund clarified that the City hasn't yet been awarded the grant, but the grant was awarded by the APO in what they call "Regional Priority Points", so now the City is in the pool to compete with other projects in Region 3 for this money. Hedlund said that the APO's giving this project Regional Priority Points does give the City of Sauk Rapids an advantage in moving forward.
