If you have ever seen the Life Alert commercials, then you will immediately have a picture in your mind of an elderly lady laying on the floor desperately trying to get up only to discover she is not able to. Whether she is just weak, has broken a hip or caused some other serious injury this image of helplessness is constantly on the mind of our elderly natients.

Working with seniors over many years it has become apparent that the greatest common fear is the fear of falling and not being able to get back up. This is not unreasonable as 1/3 of all adults over 65 will fall this year and each fall is potentially life changing.

Falling should not be your lifestyle

Falls often lead to hospitalizations, serious injury or the need for assisted living of some sort. In the most severe cases a fall can lead to death. If the fall, injury, and hospitalization isn't bad enough, frequent falls lead to loss of independence, limits in your daily activities, and increase your reliance on friends and family members to complete basic everyday tasks.

Parker County Hospital District has several programs to meet community needs

The Parker County Hospital District offers a host of services.

One of those is the Campbell Clinic, which is a family practice providing care to those patients who are two months and older. Male and female providers are available. The clinic accepts most commercial insurance, Medicaid and Medicare. Sliding scale is available upon approval. There are also inhouse lab, child and adults vaccines and workers comp for select payors. Bilingual staffers are available. To schedule an appointment, call 817-458-3300.

The district also administers the County Indigent Health Care Program, better known as the Medical

Assistance Program (MAP) for Parker County residents. Designated as the payor of last resort, MAP is designed to provide covered medical services to low-income residents who have no other public or private health care benefits and who meet all eligibility requirements of the program. MAP utilizes medical services through local physicians, hospitals, and other facilities. Eligibility is determined by residence (must live in Parker County); income, as an individual's income may not exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Level; resources, as an individual's resources may not exceed

\$1,000 per month (this includes property, checking/ savings accounts or other assets as defined by MAP regulations): citizenship, an individual must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien; and medical need, as an individual must

have a medical need of some

An outreach program for immunizations is available,

and can be acquired through the district, and child and outreach immunizations (office and mobile), cholesterol screenings, blood pressure and glucose screenings and state certified vision and hearing tests are available. For more information, call 817-458-3254.

The district has a telemedicine program, which is a partnership between Parker County schools and Parker County Hospital District to provide medical care onsite at each campus and remote clinic. Through the use of telemedicine, the healthcare needs of staff and students can be met in a convenient

setting with each campus nurse. The purpose is to increase the educational success of students and staff by assuring access to healthcare. Early treatment can decrease the need for expensive medical care and unnecessary Emergency Room visits.






