'Wayne America's Chicken Vacation' - Chicken Show 2021

The time is now for all fowl friends to make their way to Wayne for the 41st annual Wayne Chicken Show.

This year's theme is "Chicken Vacation".

Events will kick off Friday, July 9 with a Clucktique Sidewalk Sale from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Main Street in downtown Wayne.

The weekly Chamber Coffee will be hosted by the Chicken Show Committee and will be located in the 200 Block of Main Street at 10 a.m.

From 9 a.m. to noon everyone is encouraged to take part in a Chalk Walk on Third Street from Main to Pearl.

At noon, those interested in predicting the weather can take part in the KCAU Guest Weather event in the alley in the 200 Block of Main Street.

"Chickens & Other Signs of Rural Life" is the theme of the art reception at the Blue Cat Gallery, located at 114 West Third Street. The reception runs from 5 to 7 p.m. on Friday and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday.

Food, fun and craft vendors will be set up along Main Street beginning at 6 p.m. Inflatable bounce houses will be located in the downtown area.

A pie and ice cream social, hosted by Eastern Star Chapter #194 will be held in the North Meeting Room of the City Auditorium.

Evening street activities get underway at 6 p.m. with the World's Largest Chicken Dance, led by the Wayne State College and Wayne High School Cheer Squads.

The National Anthem will be sung

at 6:30 p.m. on the stage at Third and Main Streets and will be followed by a Quilts of Valor presentation.

The Cement Chicken Auction is set to take place at 7 p.m.

A saucy hot wing eating contest, sponsored by Pizza Hut, is set to begin at 8 p.m.

Entertainment for the evening will be provided by Good Morning Bedlam on the stage, beginning at 8:30 p.m.

The annual Light Up the Sky Fireworks display will begin at 10 p.m. at the Summer Sports Complex.

Saturday, July 10 starts with a 5K Chicken Run at 7 a.m. which begins at Providence Medical Center.

A co-ed sand volleyball tournament is scheduled to take place at The 4th Jug.

A Men's Slow Pitch Tournament will be held Saturday and Sunday. Details and registration information can be found on the city of Wayne's website at cac.cityofwayne.org.

The Kiwanis Omelet Feed will again be held downtown at the corner of Second and Main Streets from 7:30 to 9 a.m.

A quilt show will take place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Masonic Lodge, across the street from Bressler Park.

Activities on Saturday at Bressler Park include the live roosting crowing contest, and contests such as egg guessing events, best chicken legs, the National Cluck-Off, hard boiled egg eating contest, rubber chicken chuck, egg toss and egg drop/catch.

Arts, crafts, fun and food vendors will be available at the park throughout the day, as will cluck-tible souvenirs.

Inflatables will be at the park all day, sponsored by Great Dane and Pac 'N' Save.

Dusty Road Petting Zoo will be located in the park all day.

The Chicken Show Parade begins at 9:30 a.m. at First and Main and travels north on Main Street to 10th Street and then west on 10th Street to Bressler Park.

The Wayne County Museum, located at Seventh and Lincoln Streets, will be open from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday.

Entertainment during the noon hour at the park will be provided by Reinvented Wheels from noon to 1 p.m.

Ice cream bars will again be provided by Great Dane Trailers, starting at noon, while supplies last.

A Cornhole Tournament will take place at The 4th Jug, beginning at 1 p.m.

A 3-on-3 tournament will take place at the Community Activity Center. Details and registration are available at cac.cityofwayne.org

Planetarium shows will be presented at noon, 1, 2, 3 and 4 p.m. at the Carhart Science Building on the Wayne State College campus. Free tickets will be available at the Information Booth in Bressler Park.

An all-class social hour for Wayne High alumni will begin at 6 p.m. at the Wayne City Auditorium.

Sons of Satan will perform at the Wayne City Auditorium and will be hosted by the Wayne Schools' Foundation.

The final event of the day will be a

free Outdoor Movie at Bressler Park at 9 p.m.

A number of events on Sunday, July 11 will take place on Second Street, between Main and Pearl Streets and along Pearl Street.

Cluck-tibles will be available for purchase at the Souvenir Table throughout the morning.

The Crowing Motors Car Show will take place from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. All vehicles are welcome. Prizes will be awarded on a spectator vote.

Reinvented Wheels will provide music at Bressler Park beginning at 5 p.m. on Sunday.

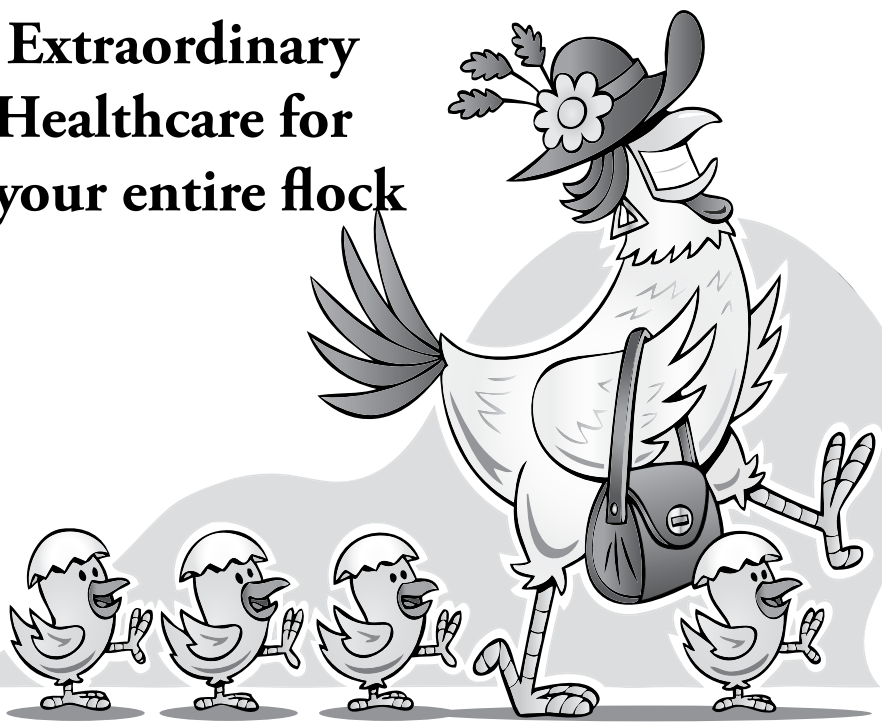

History of the Chicken Show

The Wayne Chicken Show, sponsored by the Wayne Area Economic Development Office, is a fun event held the weekend that contains the second Saturday in July.

The first Wayne Chicken Show was held in 1981 and was intended to be an arts and crafts show. It was a project of the Wayne Regional Arts Council and its purpose was to generate grass roots interest in art by demonstrating that art can exist around everyday objects or situations.

The theme of "chickens" was chosen because of the potential for art materials (feathers & egg shells), because nearly everyone has knowledge and familiarity with chickens and because chickens can be considered with humor. Some contests and a parade were planned in order to make the arts and crafts show an event.

Previous years' Cluck Off winners have appeared on the Tonight Show, Jay Leno and Live with Regis and Kelly. The Chicken Show has been featured in nearly all of the larger Nebraskan newspapers; on radio interviews heard in every state of the United States, all provinces of Canada and the B.C. originating from Dublin, Ireland; in television news segments each year on Lincoln, Omaha and Sioux City stations, and on NBC, ABC, CBS and CNN; appearances on Good Morning America, the Mickey Mouse Club and a syndicated quiz show; and in articles in USA Today and Wall Street Journal, Stars and Stripes, regional magazines, national newspaper syndications throughout the Associated Press and UPI. In addition, English, Japanese and Saudi Arabian newspaper clippings

have been sent to members of the chicken show committee.

The primary source of funds for the Chicken Show is the sale of Chicken Shirts and other "cluck"tible items. Each year's t-shirt is unique, depicting the theme for that particular year, which this year is "Chickens Around the World." Thousands of shirts are sold each year, and calls and orders are taken all year.

The Wayne Chicken Show received the 1996 Nebraska Outstanding Tourism Award and was selected in 1999, along with four other community events in Nebraska, to be featured in the Library of Congress. In 2001, the Chicken Show was awarded the "People's Choice Award" for the Best Community Event in northeast Nebraska. In recent years, a number of "Wacky Events" websites have fea-

tured the Chicken Show as the place to be the second Saturday of July.

Many of the events have continued throughout the past 39 years, such as the Omelet Feed, the National Cluck-Off, the Egg Drop, the Best Chicken Legs on a Human and the parade. New events have been added as the event has now been expanded to include Friday evening (Henoween) activities held in downtown Wayne and Sunday, Last Cluck, events, including a car show and Poker Run.

In addition to all the chicken-related activities, the Chicken Show serves as a backdrop to numerous class reunions for those who have graduated from both Wayne High School and Haun High School. Classmates can often be found throughout the community and on floats at the Chicken Show Parade.

Good Morning Bedlam

Good Morning Bedlam to perform on Henoween

Taking the stage on Henoween, Friday, July 9 will be the group Good Morning Bedlam.

Good Morning Bedlam has become an innovative force in the Midwest folk scene and beyond, with shows in 44 states. Their performances display contagious energy as members careen about the stage, jumping and dancing with a wild playfulness. They captivate their audiences night after night with tight, soaring three part harmonies, thumping kick drum, catchy violin melodies, and song writing that speaks to the heart.

Good Morning Bedlam released their sophomore album, Like Kings, in July of 2018. In June of 2019, GMB ended their first full touring year of two hundred-plus shows by winning first place at the John Hartford Memorial Festival Band Competition. In 2020 the band stayed busy by writing and releasing new music, such as their most recent single 'Enough' along with its own music video.


