





History of the Chicken Show

The Wayne Chicken Show, sponsored by the Wayne Area Economic Development Office, is a fun event held the weekend that contains the second Saturday in July.

The first Wayne Chicken Show was held in 1981 and was intended to be an arts and crafts show. It was a project of the Wayne Regional Arts Council and its purpose was to generate grass roots interest in art by demonstrating that art can exist around everyday objects or situations.

The theme of "chickens" was chosen because of the potential for art materials (feathers & egg shells), because nearly everyone has knowledge and familiarity with chickens and because chickens can be considered with humor. Some contests and a parade were planned in order to make the arts and crafts show an event.

The Chicken Show has been featured in nearly all of the larger Nebraskan newspapers; on radio interviews heard in every state of the United States, all provinces of Canada and the B.C. originating from Dublin, Ireland; in television news segments each year on Lincoln, Omaha and Sioux City stations, and on NBC, ABC, CBS and CNN; appearances on Good Morning America, the Mickey Mouse Club and a syndicated quiz show; and in articles in USA Today and Wall Street Journal, Stars and Stripes, regional magazines, national newspaper syndications throughout the Associated Press and UPI. In addition, English, Japanese and Saudi Arabian newspaper clippings

The primary source of funds for the Chicken Show is the sale of Chicken Shirts and other "cluck"tible items. Each year's t-shirt is unique, depicting the theme for that particular year, which this year is "Chickens Around the World." Thousands of shirts are sold each year, and calls and orders are taken all year.

The Wayne Chicken Show received the 1996 Nebraska Outstanding Tourism Award and was selected in 1999, along with four other community events in Nebraska, to be featured in the Library of Congress. In 2001, the Chicken Show was awarded the "People's Choice Award" for the Best Community Event in northeast Nebraska. In recent years, a number of "Wacky Events" websites have fea-







Good Morning Bedlam to perform on Henoween

Taking the stage on Henoween, Friday, July 9 will be the group Good Morning Bedlam.

Good Morning Bedlam has become an innovative force in the Midwest folk scene and beyond, with shows in 44 states. Their performances display contagious energy as members careen about the stage, jumping and dancing with a wild playfulness. They captivate their audiences night after night with tight, soaring three part harmonies, thumping kick drum, catchy violin melodies, and song writing that speaks to the heart.

Good Morning Bedlam released their sophomore album, Like Kings, in July of 2018. In June of 2019, GMB ended their first full touring year of two hundred-plus shows by winning first place at the John Hartford Memorial Festival Band Competition. In 2020 the band stayed busy by writing and releasing new music, such as their most recent single 'Enough' along with its own music video.
