Mosquitos spread germs that can make you sick


Protect yourself and your family from mosquito bites

Mosquitoes can spread viruses like West Nile Virus & Zika

- Use insect repellent. DEET, Picaridin, Oil of lemon eucalyptus, or any other EPA registered insect repellent.
- Do not let children under 10 apply repellent themselves.
- Insect repellent can be used on infants older than 2 months.
- Wear long sleeved shirts and long pants. Treat clothing and gear with permethrin.
- Spray insect repellent onto your hands and then apply to a child.
- Use screens on your windows and doors to keep mosquitoes outdoors. Mosquitos bite day and night.
- Do not apply repellent to a child's hands, eyes, mouth, or cuts.
- Cover crib, stroller or carrier with mosquito netting.
