CITY OF WAYNE PET REGISTRATION RENEWAL MONTH

Starting May 1st thru May 31, 2024 all pet registrations must be renewed for all dogs and cats within the city limits of Wayne. Registration fees during this period will be \$6.00 per dog or cat. Current proof of rabies vaccinations will be needed at time of licensing. Licenses can be obtained at the

Wayne Police Department 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. On or after June 1, 2024, all pet registrations will be considered delinquent with an increased fee of \$21.00 per pet. Non compliance could result in a court appearance for failing to license your pets.
