All types of severe weather events can cause damage or make utility equipment difficult to access Keep You and Yours Safe -Install a weather app for severe weather notifications

-Install a Weather app for severe weather notifications -Shelter in a safe area. (Storm warning=take action) -Have an evacuation plan in place (e.g., for floods, wildfires) -Make sure your emergency kit is properly stocked and up to date -Place a portable generator at least 20 feet away from doors & windows -Use a generator in an open area (not in a garage, carport or enclosed space) -Ensure carbon monoxide alarms are installed on every level of your home

Keep Others Safe

Do not plug a generator into a wall outlet, which can cause backfeed Backfeed means that power can go from your home back into the power grid and endanger crews that are working to restore power

During Clean Up

-If there is an outage, do not go outdoors until the power has been restored -Ice, snow, standing water or storm debris could cover downed power lines -Never approach downed power lines; call 911 to report it & alert others to stay away

-Do not trim trees/branches within 10 ft of overhead power lines
