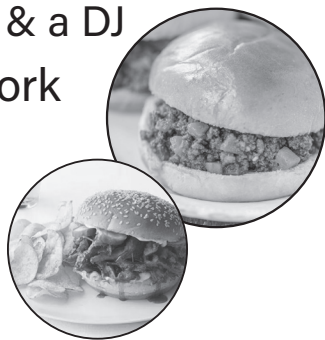

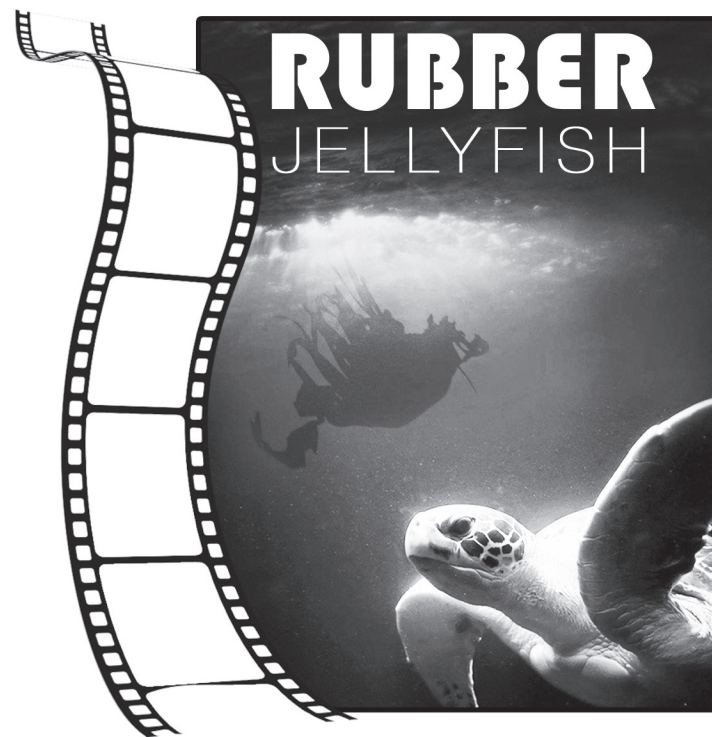

## A Storm warning means **TAKE ACTION**

All types of severe weather events can cause  
damage or make utility equipment difficult to access

### Keep You and Yours Safe

- Install a weather app for severe weather notifications
- Shelter in a safe area. (Storm warning=take action)
- Have an evacuation plan in place (e.g., for floods, wildfires)
- Make sure your emergency kit is properly stocked and up to date
- Place a portable generator at least 20 feet away from doors & windows
- Use a generator in an open area (not in a garage, carport or enclosed space)
- Ensure carbon monoxide alarms are installed on every level of your home

### Keep Others Safe

Do not plug a generator into a wall outlet, which can cause backfeed  
Backfeed means that power can go from your home back into the power  
grid and endanger crews that are working to restore power

### During Clean Up

- If there is an outage, do not go outdoors until the power has been restored
- Ice, snow, standing water or storm debris could cover downed power lines
- Never approach downed power lines; call 911 to report it &  
alert others to stay away
- Do not trim trees/branches within 10 ft of overhead power lines

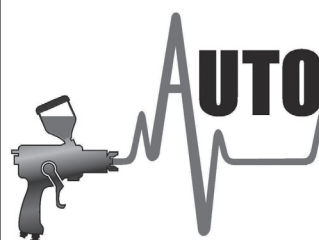

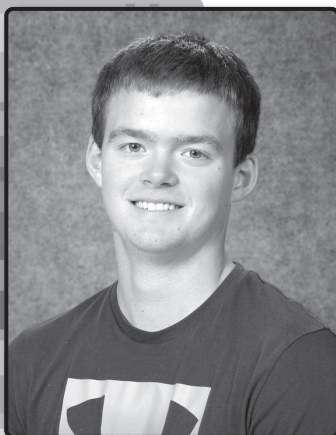
# Students of the Month
